
GUEST LECTURE SERIES

The Smart Blind Stick is designed to assist visually impaired individuals in navigating their surroundings. The device features is beep that sounds when objects are detected and vibrations to indicate the proximity and direction of the obstacle. To turn on the device, press the power button. The device will beep once to confirm it has been turned on. The device is always in detection mode when powered on. The beep will sound when an object is detected and the vibration intensity will increase as the object gets closer. The device has a replaceable battery. The battery life will depend on usage. Blind stick project based on IOT is developed by SYBCA students Ms. Sanjana Pedhadiya, Ms. Maitry Gothi, Ms. Nemi Patel and Ms. Pammy Nakrani under the guidance of Dr. Dikshan Shah (Assist. Professor, Department of Computer Science). Demonstration of IOT based project was held at **Srirangam Srimad Andavan Ashramam** on 2nd February 2023. It was highly appreciated by the ashram's residents. That was a wonderful moment for the department as a whole and our students' efforts.





• Secured 1st position in Badminton (Male) in Annual Sports Day for staff Members organized by Vanita Vishram Women's University on January 28, 2023.
