Zardozi embroidery is a type of embroidery wherein gold and silver threads are used to make exquisite designs on cloth. These handicraft products may be segmented on the basis of decorative value and utility. It has great potential to provide employment opportunities.



With this view a workshop on 'Zardozi Embroidery' was organized for the students from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> December 2021. They learnt the use of various zardozi materials and implemented it to customize clothes, wearable textiles and crafts.

### Workshop on Fabric painting



Painting provides a platform to showcase one's creativity. When applied on fabric it can turn a dull fabric into a piece of art.



Fabric Painting workshop in collaboration with Pidilite Industries was organised on 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2021 for the students of Fashion Designing, where the students learnt various techniques of fabric painting. This workshop helped the students to explore their hidden talent and create beautiful garments, accessories and home furnishing.

### Movie Screening - Cruella
