




#### PRACTICAL ASPECTS OF AUDITING

#### ACADEMIC GUEST LECTURE ON TIME VALUE OF MONEY

On 17<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 an academic guest lecture was organized for S.Y.B.B.A. students. The resource person, **Dr. Krunal Patel** (Assistant Professor, UKA Tarsadia University) explained the basic concept of changing value of money at different time periods. He discussed the concept of discounting and compounding along with their relation with present value and future value concepts. Further, he demonstrated the computation of future value and present value of lumpsum and annuity using present value tables. Towards the end, Dr. Krunal Patel also showed the computation of present value using MS excel to the students. The session was inclusive of live interaction in the form of question – answer and all the queries of the students were satisfactorily solved. 82 participants benefitted from the session and they learnt about computation of time value of money using table method and with the help of spreadsheet like MS excel. It was coordinated by **Dr. Bosky Suratwala** (H.o.D- Dept. of Management) and **Ms. Divya Patel** (Asst. Professor, JDSCM).






#### DIGITAL DETOX-DISCONNECT TO CONNECT






### A SESSION ON 'HOW TO CRACK M.B.A ENTRANCE EXAMS'
