Any Act Resulting in:

- Indecent Behaviour
- Criminal Intimidation/wrongful Restraint
- Undermining Human Dignity
- Financial Exploitation/extortion
- Use Of Force

A STUDENT INVOLVED IN RAGGING CAN BE:

- Suspension of admission
- Suspension from attending classes
- Withdrawal/withdrawing Scholarship/Fellowship and other benefits
- Deterring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process
- Withholding results
- Expulsion from representing the institution in any sports/ cultural or inter-collegiate event, tournament or sports festival etc.
- **Discontinue admission** - when the person involved in ragging or the person of ragging are not identified the institution shall report to respective authorities as a default to ensure disciplinary process as per college report




In the collective glow of our beloved faculty, we witness the united spirit and enthusiasm that characterizes the lively academic family of SOHASS.


VVWU CLUBS- THEATRE GEEKS SESSION ON SHORT FILM MAKING
