EXPERT TALKS

EXPERT TALK ON TYPE, TECHNIQUES, AND LANGUAGE IN DRAMA



The speaker **Dr. Sapna Desai, Adhyapak Sahayak** from **Smt J.P. Shroff Arts College, Valsad** delivered the expert talk on **Types, Techniques, and Language in Drama** on **October 10, 2024**, to the First Year students of the Department of English. Around 80 students benefited from the event. The students learned about various forms and methods of dramatic expression and the evolving language of theatre. The students got to know about different genres of drama including tragedy, comedy, melodrama, and modern experimental form. The session covered the essential techniques used by playwrights and directors to bring stories to life on stage, such as monologue, dialogue, soliloquy, and the use of symbolism.

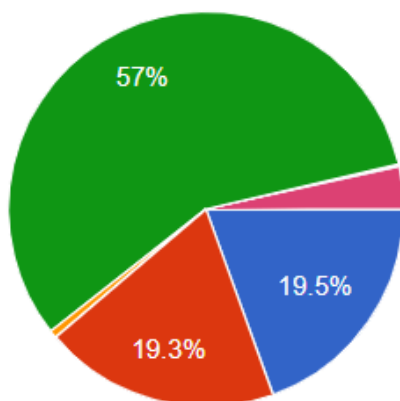


WORLD MENTAL HEALTH DAY

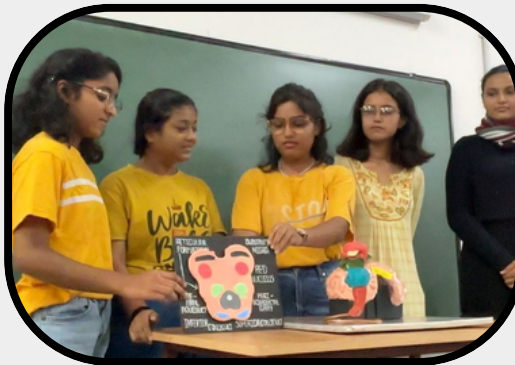

HISTORY

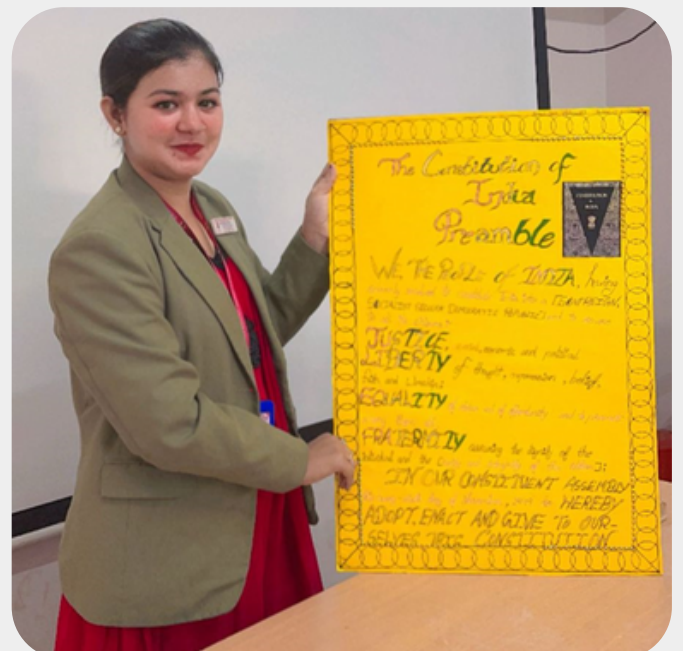
PARLIAMENTARY DEBATE

MOVIE ON ANCIENT INDIAN EDUCATION SYSTEM



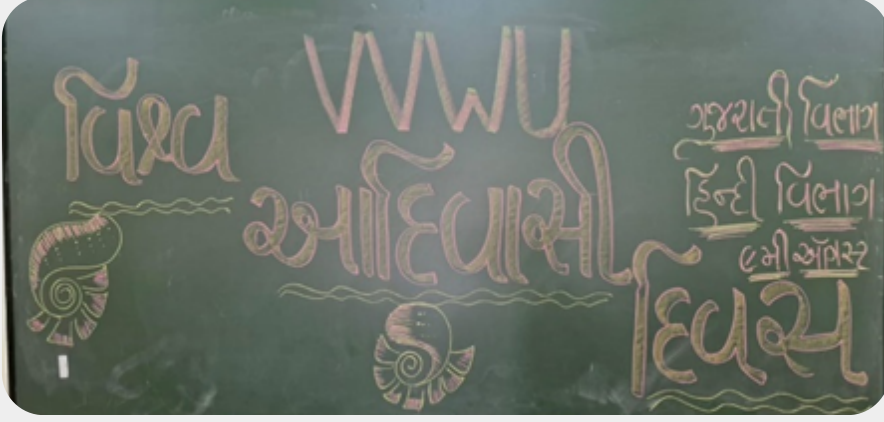

ENGLISH



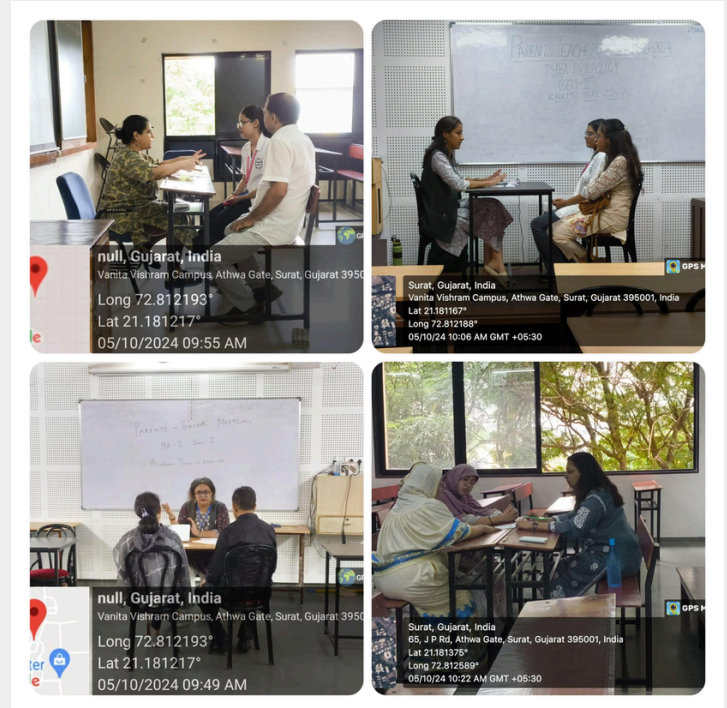

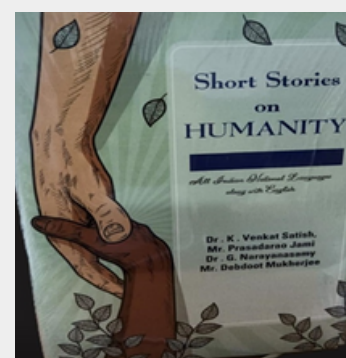
