"Understanding Sources"



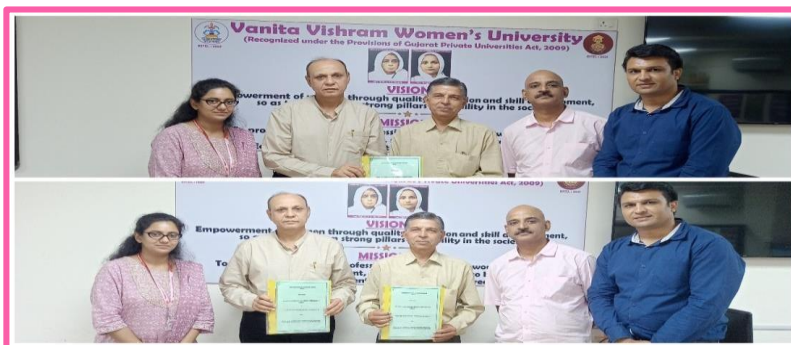

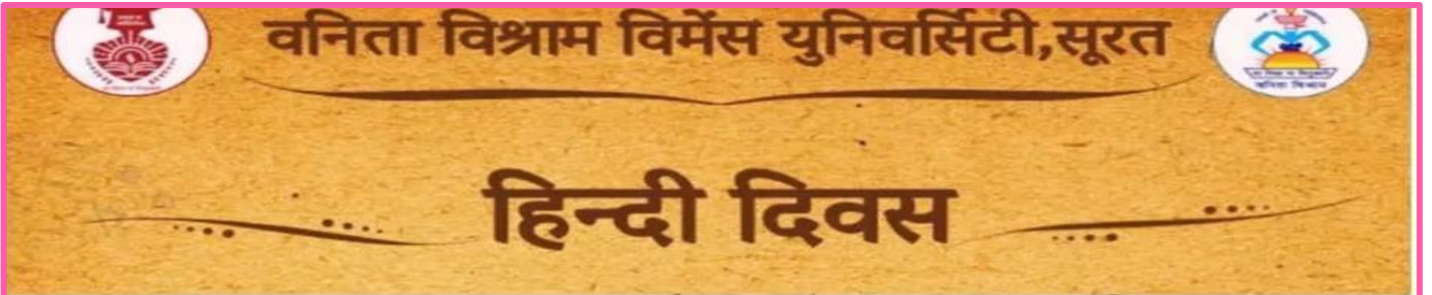
